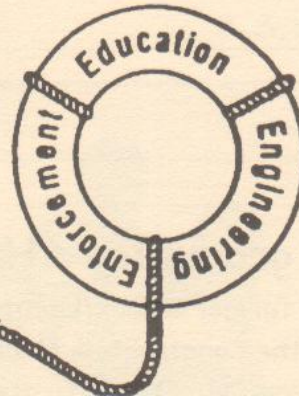

Duties include:

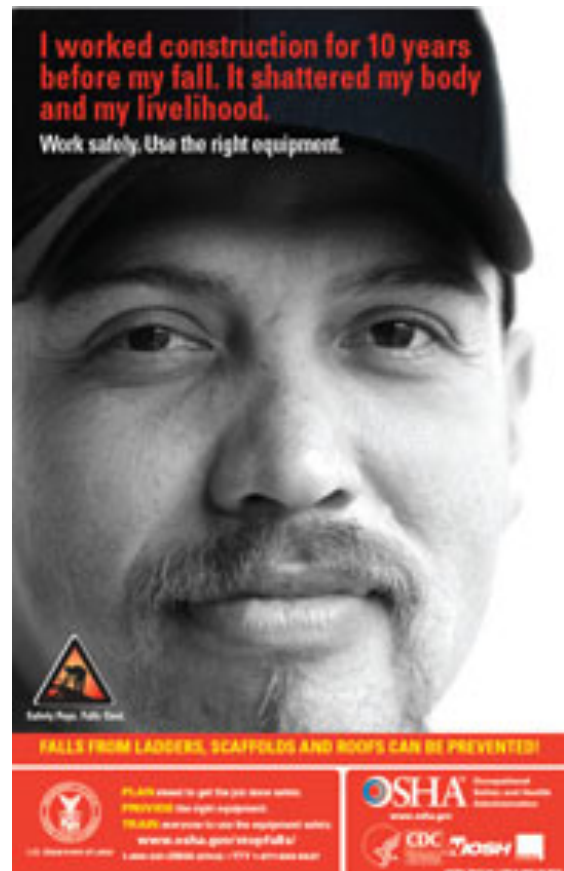
- Develop Activity Hazard Analyses for submission to the Government
