

## 2019 National Safety Stand-Down to Prevent Falls in Construction

**Texas, California, New York,** and **Florida** held the highest number of stand-downs across the United States.


85 stand-downs were held internationally, reaching 56,439 workers abroad.




## Reaching At-Risk Workers...

**38%** of stand-downs held were for fewer than 20 workers.

Of the 290 stand-downs in residential construction,
75 were for fewer than 20 workers.
