

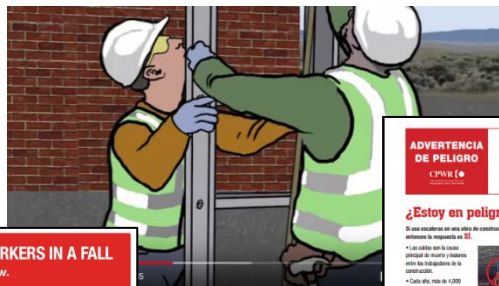


**The 7th annual National Safety Stand-Down to Prevent Falls will take place the week of September 14-18, 2020!**

Falls remain the leading cause of death for construction workers. The National Campaign to Prevent Falls in Construction was created in 2012 in order to draw attention to and address the hazard, and the Safety Stand-Down event was added in 2014. The 2020 Stand-Down, originally scheduled for May, is now taking place in September. This nationwide weeklong event is an opportunity for employers to pause work and have conversations with workers about fall hazards, protective methods, and their company’s safety policies, goals and expectations.

CPWR, NIOSH, and OSHA have created a number of resources and materials to make it easy for companies of all types and sizes to participate – with a focus on holding virtual and socially distanced events this year.
